- The USFS held a CFLR monitoring working group meeting on April 24th to review the progress made on individual monitoring projects, discuss plans for the season, and review whether or not we are still on track to complete projects that haven't started yet. Michelle will be sending out a list of monitoring projects that are planned for the 2019 season and hopes to hold a multiparty monitoring meeting prior to our next collaborative group meeting to discuss.

Sierra Nevada Conservancy

- SNC's Healthy Forests Funding Program anticipates having the Request for Proposals announced in mid-June. Pre-applications will be due by July 26, site visits will be in August/September, and final applications will be due October 24th. A little over \$10 million is available and the guidelines are slated to be very similar to our last cycle, which includes up to \$1 million for implementation projects and \$100k for planning projects. This will be the last round of SNC Prop 1 forest health funding.
- Other SNC Funding Opportunities – In addition to the Forest Health funding, SNC has several other funding opportunities. They include: Resilient Sierra Nevada Communities, Vibrant Recreation and Tourism, and Strategic Lands Conserved. Visit our website to review grant guidelines. Sometimes, we have other small pots of monies that might be applicable for certain types of projects so feel free to consult with Kristy to find out more.
- EO visit – Our new Executive Officer, Angela Avery, will be in Shasta, Lassen and Modoc Counties on June 18-19th. I'm in the process of setting up meetings, including a few representatives of the Burney Hat Creek Group. Our Assistant Executive Officer, Bob Kingman, will be retiring in June and his replacement will be Julie Alvis. Julie previously worked for the California Natural Resources Agency as the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Administration and Finance.
